Her international experience includes anchoring and editing “The Asian Wall Street Journal Report”, hosting the documentary series “Emerging Powers” in 1996 and in 1994, hosting the PBS special “The Pacific Rift”.

Prior to her television career, Consuelo Mack worked for investment firms such as Mitchell Hutchins and Merrill Lynch.
